


This survey is made for the benefit of Southern Farm Bureau Life Insurance Company.

The point or place of beginning being an iron pipe located on the westerly right-of-way line of U.S. Route 17 where said right-of-way line intersects with the property of the United States of America.

The point of beginning being established thusly; thence departing said right-of-way line of U.S. Route 17 N 58° 00' 13" W, a distance of 177.05 feet to an iron pipe, thence N 20° 18' 15" W, a distance of 197.43 feet to an iron pipe, thence N 25° 13' 41" E, a distance of 21.03 feet to an iron pipe, thence S 64° 46' 19" E, a distance of 307.77 feet to an iron pipe, located on the westerly right-of-way line of U.S. Route 17, thence along a curve to the left having a radius of 9,629.27 feet, an arc distance of 180.42 feet to an iron pipe and the point or place of beginning.
