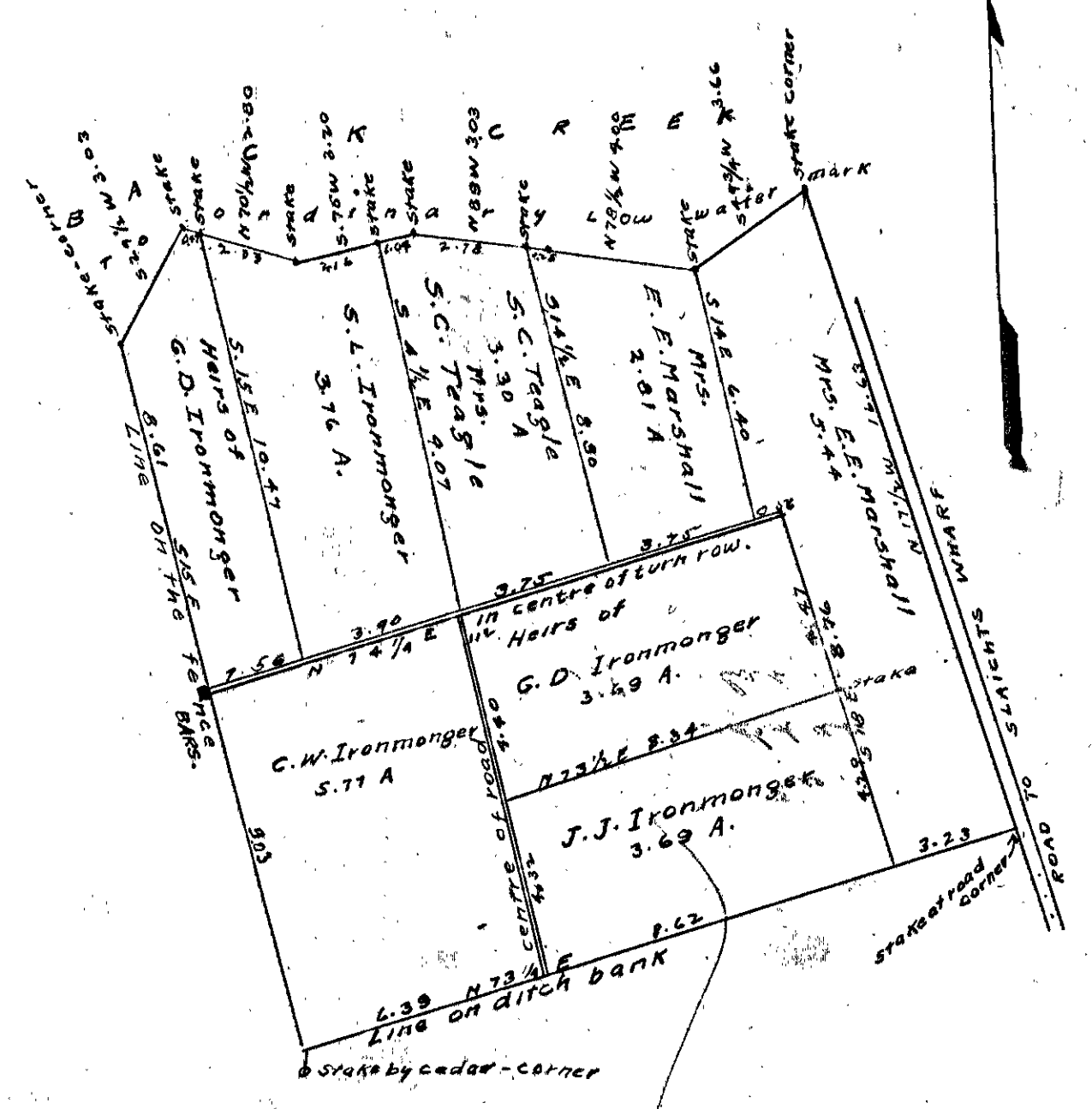
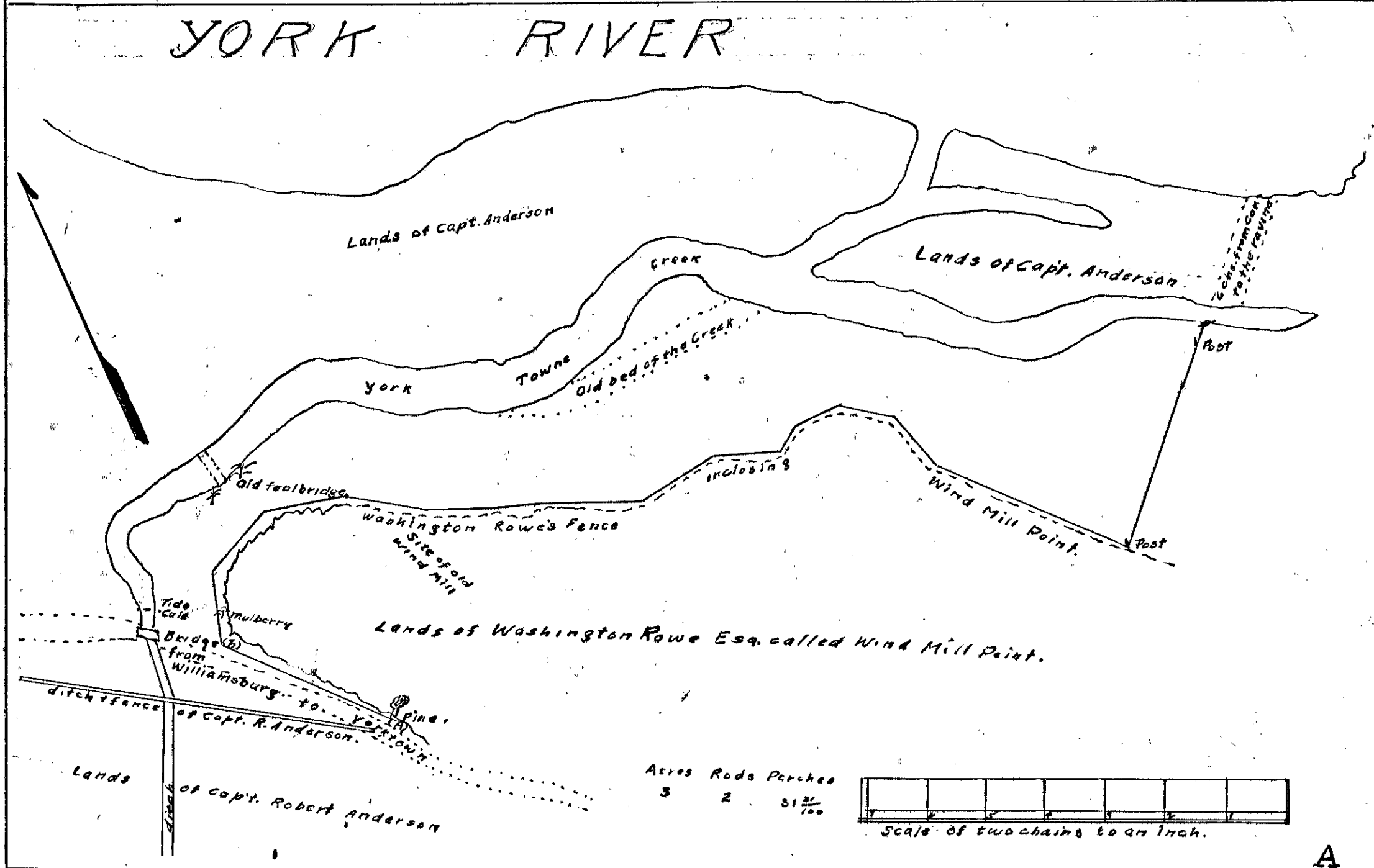

I, Fielding D. Piggott, Surveyor for the County of James City do hereby certify that under an attested copy of an entry made by Capt. Robert Anderson in the Clerk's Office of York County on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June 1850 for certain vacant & unappropriated land in said entry specified & by virtue of a Land Office Treasury Warrant # 12698. for five hundred acres bearing date 27<sup>th</sup> of August 1836 to me delivered by said Anderson, I have surveyed at his request the lot or parcel of land in said entry specified, situate & lying in said County immediately above York Town and adjoining the land of the proprietors & included in the boundaries last down in the above part and find the same to contain three acres two rods & thirty one 1/2 Perches after deducting 36 1/2% rods the area embraced by the Stage road running through the same, - Given under my hand this 29<sup>th</sup> day of June 1850.
