To the circuit court of York County

Your surveyor reported that on the 25th of Feb. 1871 having been engaged by commissioners Ware, Gray et al. to make a survey of that portion of land called the Goodwin tract and to divide the land into ten lots pursuant to a decree rendered by the Circuit Court of York Co. at the September Term 1868 in the Chancery suit of Elliott vs. Curtis & Weybrows he completed the same pursuant to area of the tracts to be 59.4 acres, and that of one of the units to be 5.94. The division lines are marked in red and run parallel with the main road. Check line between No. 9 & No. 10 which runs to white oak. The points of division on the Western side of the tract are marked by stakes and the distance between those points shown by the plat herewith returned.
