

The map or plat hereto attached is a subdivision of Cemetery Lots only of that certain tract of land located in the County of York, Virginia, containing three (3) acres, more or less, and bounded and described as follows: All that certain piece or parcel of land in Poquoson Magisterial District, York County, Virginia, and containing three (3) acres, be the same more or less, and described in general as follows: Beginning at the southern boundary line of the burial lot of J. S. Hopkins, E. J. Moore, Sr. and L. H. Hogue, thence running back between parallel lines far enough to contain said three acres of land and bounded on the North by the burial lot of J. S. Hopkins, E. J. Moore, Sr. and L. H. Hogue; East by a twenty (20) foot road; South by the land of L. H. Hogue and West by the land of S. J. Moore; and also that certain twenty (20) foot right of way beginning at the main County Road at the northeast corner of Marcus Baptist Church lot, thence along and parallel with the eastern boundary line of the burial lot of L. H. Hogue; thence along and parallel with the eastern boundary line of the above mentioned three (3) acres of land, and being the same land conveyed to the Poquoson Cemetery Company, Inc. by three deeds, one from George S. Riggins et als, which deed is recorded in Deed Book 51, page 242, one from Maggie E. Phillips, widow, recorded in Deed Book 51, page 244, and one from L. H. Hogue, recorded in Deed Book 51, page 255.

And this is to certify that the said map or plat showing subdivision of said three acres of land as Poquoson Cemetery Company, Inc., is signed and recorded with the consent and in accordance with the desire of George S.
