



This SURVEY CONTROL MAP OF YORKTOWN, Virginia was made on the 15 day of February, 1949, by R. F. Pyle, Eng., from the original surveys and plats of the Town of York, to-wit: Lawrence Smith's Survey of 1691; the Waller Plan of 1788; and the Hudgins Plan of 1889, by order of the Trustees of the Town of York; and by resolution and Order of the said Trustees, adopted at a Called Meeting of said Trustees held on the 14th day of March, 1949. Said Map, with its Courses, Distances, Monuments and Fixed Control Points, was accepted and adopted as the Authentic and Official Map and Layout of the Town of York, Virginia.
